Which is iPool's priority?

iPool is a European consortium which aims to design and implement effective provision for enhancing the basic skills (literacy, numeracy and digital) and key competences of specific adult target groups that are currently not well served.

Who is its target?

- Low-skilled adults.

Who are the other key stakeholders?

- Teachers from adult schools, education centres or universities.
- NGO operators; volunteers and employers.
- National and European institutions and associations, national and EU policy makers.



Why?

Deficiencies in basic skills and key competencies could be eliminated if proper methods and tools are used but the problem is that low-skilled adults can't take advantage of many non-formal existing tools for development of their competences because they either don't know about their existence or are not able to find or use them.

Which are iPool's objectives?

Addressing low-skilled people and giving them the tool (with clear instructions how to use it) that will help them to find other tools and learn about and through them.

How will the objectives be achieved?

- Gathering previous European tools and practices in one.
- Designing an interactive tool: not just gathering, but also allowing target groups to enter their own information.
- Involving target groups into the development, paying special attention to the design of the tool.
- Empowering target groups to develop whatever skills they lack (from the area of literacy, numeracy or any other).
